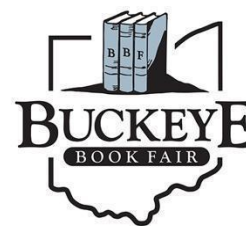

## **New York Times Bestselling Author Shannon Hale to Headline Young Authors Conference and Excellence Awards in Wooster on October 30**

WOOSTER, OH — The Buckeye Book Fair in partnership with Wayne County Public Library and Tri-County Educational Service Center is proud to announce the 2025 Young Authors Conference and the inaugural Young Authors Excellence Award Ceremony, both taking place on Thursday, October 30 at the Greystone Event Center in Wooster, Ohio. These inspiring literary events will celebrate student creativity, recognize exceptional young writers, and feature a keynote presentation by beloved New York Times bestselling author Shannon Hale.

Best known for *Princess Academy*, *Real Friends*, and *Kind of a Big Deal*, Shannon Hale has won legions of fans with her powerful storytelling and her advocacy for young readers, especially girls. Her appearance will cap off a day designed to ignite imagination and foster a lifelong love of reading and writing in Ohio's youth.

During the daytime Young Authors Conference, students in grades 3–8 will participate in engaging workshops with published authors and illustrators, learn about the creative process, and build confidence in their own storytelling skills. That evening, the spotlight will shine on excellence as one outstanding young writer from each participating school will be honored during the Young Authors Excellence Award Ceremony. These students have been nominated by their teachers for their dedication, originality, and passion for writing.
